- 1992 – Caracas, Venezuela
- 2003 – Durban, South Africa
- 2014 – Sydney, Australia

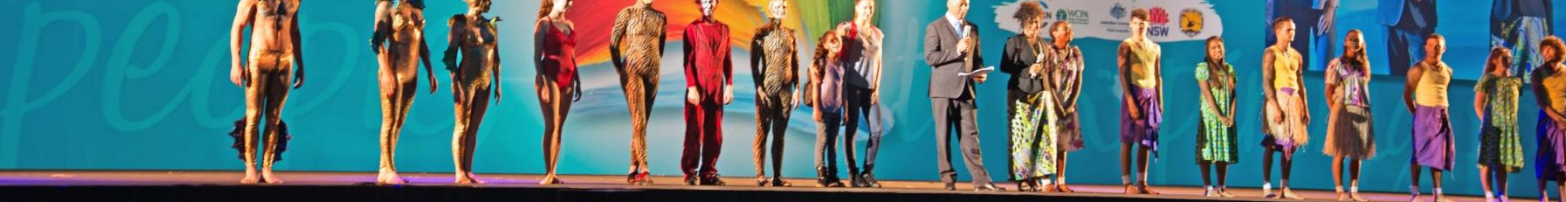
